Dear Parents and / or Guardians,


I want to send an update regarding the food service program that will be offered during the school closing for any student that depends on our school food service program. Beginning on March 18, 2020 students aged 18 or younger are eligible to obtain free meals on-site at Duquesne Elementary – Administrative / Business Office entrance located on Kennedy Avenue.

For any student aged 18 or younger in need of meal services, bulk Grab n' Go breakfasts and lunches for the week will be available. To keep students, community members, and staff exposure to health risks a minimum, bulk meals will be provided only on Monday's and Wednesday's. Pick up will be at the Business Office / Administration entrance lobby at Duquesne Elementary School from 11:00 AM – 1:00 PM on Mondays and Wednesdays during the school closure.

The meals provided on Mondays will be for: Monday & Tuesday. Meals provided on Wednesdays will be for: Wednesday, Thursday, & Friday. Children will receive (2) breakfasts and (2) lunches on Monday and (3) breakfasts and (3) lunches on Wednesday in pre-packed Grab n' Go bags. If an eligible child has a food allergy please notify serving staff prior to accepting meal(s).

Meals provided are for any child aged 18 and younger residing within the city limits of Duquesne.
